



Call for Catering Bids

Background:

During a typical school day, The Lower Nicola Indian Band School has provided a hot breakfast and lunch for 112 students from 71 homes. Many families have come to rely on their school-aged children receiving these nutritious no-cost meals.

During this time of stay-at-home isolation, The LNIB Education department would like to continue to provide **occasional** fresh-prepared meal to its students.

Details

- Require a caterer to create 112 fresh meals, packaged for delivery.
- To ensure freshness, we prefer the meals to be prepared in the morning so the school could load up the busses in the afternoon and deliver to families.
- To ensure a safe, sanitized environment is being used for the preparation of the meals either the Rocky Pines or school kitchen will be made available.
- The caterer **MUST** follow all food health and safety standards and some additional requirements including wearing gloves, face masks, and face guards. LNIB may be able to supply some of these.

Current employees of LNIB are NOT eligible to quote on this Bid opportunity.

Please submit with your proposal;

- 1. two meal options each including**
 - a. a main course,**
 - b. fruit/veggie,**
 - c. beverage (eg; juice box)**
 - d. light dessert**
 - e. cost per meal**
- 2. details of each meal; Itemized contents.**
 - a. [as example each meal will contain a sandwich with a minimum 100 grams of meat (turkey, ham, or beef), a tomato slice, lettuce, butter/mayo, a 200ml juice box, 200 grams of sliced mixed veggies or side salad. 100 gram desert (cake, brownie, or cookie)].**
