



- 2016 LNIB Land Code is ratified
- 2019 LNIB begins project to learn more about traditional lands
- Learning from members about traditional land ownership and decision-making
- Hearing from members families about how new laws could reflect traditional processes

# WHAT'S HAPPENING NOW?

- A draft Allotment Law has been prepared by LNIB
- The draft law includes steps for granting custom family allotments on members' traditional holdings
- The draft law is ready for community review



### WORKING WITH THE COMMUNITY

- Community engagement so far has included:
  - Open houses
  - Family group meetings
  - Guidance from LMAC
  - One-on-one discussions with members
- COVID-19 has delayed in-person meetings
