Traditional Holdings Project Update #1 Meeting Rules

We understand that discussing traditional land holdings/custom family lands is a sensitive and controversial subject that can bring up a lot of emotions for Members and their families. During this meeting participants will be given the option to share their thoughts, questions, and concerns in a considerate and respectful manner. To ensure that frustrations do not turn into personal attacks or crass language the rules below were developed for this meeting to provide Members with a safe space to provide their opinion and feedback.

- 1. Respect each Member equally and their various perspectives, opinions, and beliefs.
- 2. Lateral Violence or Abuse will <u>NOT</u> be tolerated which includes the following:
 - No yelling or swearing
 - No personal attacks; and
 - No bullying

Not following rule #2 will result in receiving two reminders about the conduct expected during the meeting and if the behavior continues you may be muted for the remainder of the meeting and/or requested leave

- 3. Participants will need to identify themselves upon entering the meeting and before speaking.
- 4. Questions to be held until the end or designated time by the presenter.
- 5. Time limits may be implemented depending on the number of participates. (i.e., 5-minutes per participant)
- 6. We encourage Members to submit their questions in advance via email or to utilize the chat feature during the meeting to ensure their questions are addressed and to avoid interruptions.
