### LAW-MAKING POWERS

Council may make Laws, following the Land Code, that relate to LNIB Lands. As laid out in Section 6.2 of the LNIB Land Code, these Laws may relate to:

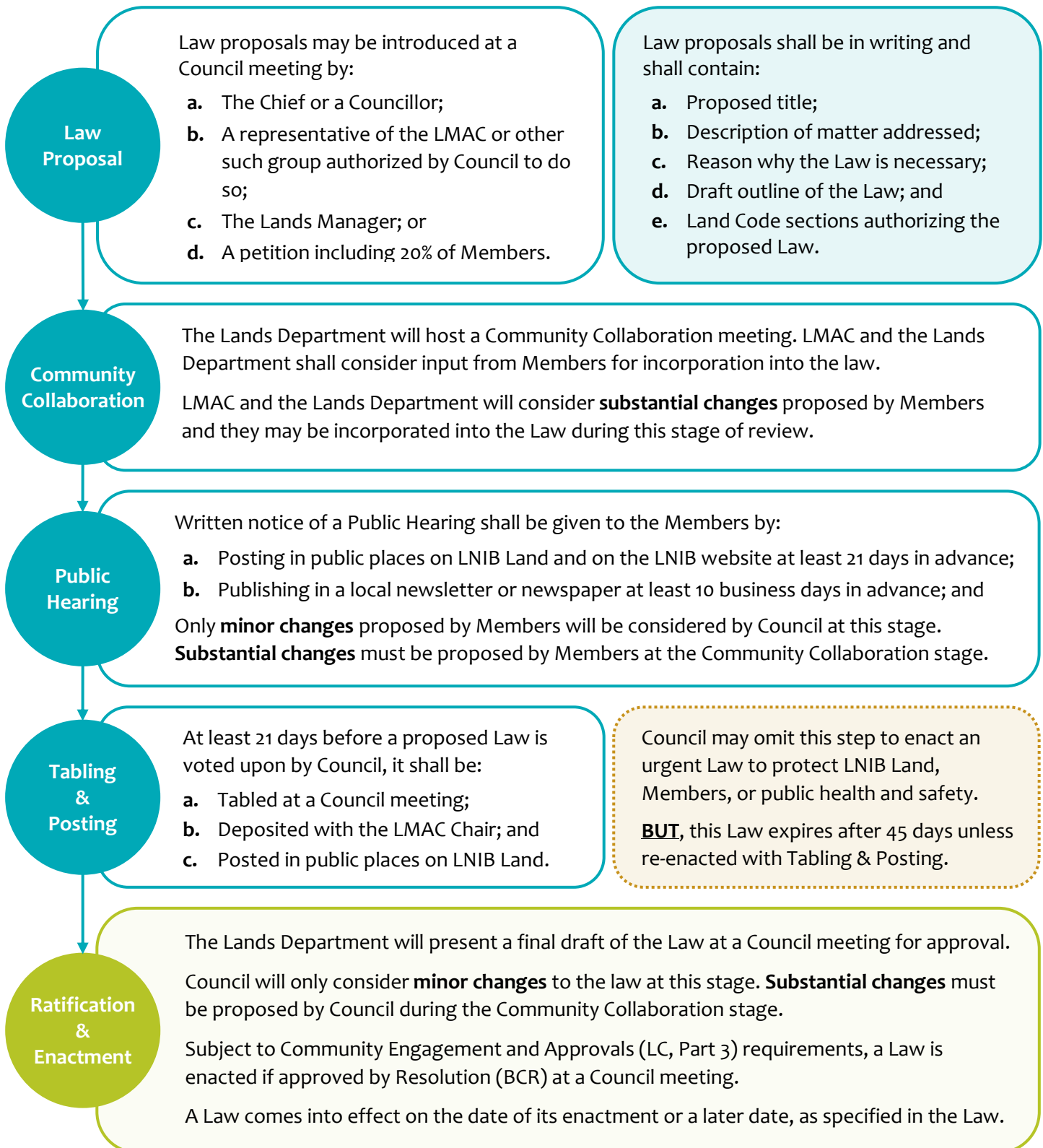

## LAW-MAKING PROCEDURE

Section 7 of the LNIB Land Code (LC) describes the development process for LNIB Laws, carried out as:



## LAW-MAKING ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

### Chief & Council

- Ensure Laws developed are consistent with Land Code for management, administration, use, and protection of LNIB Lands.
- Comply with mandatory law-making procedures in the Land Code (Parts 2 & 3) during Law development.
- Propose substantial changes to laws during the Community Collaboration stage.
- Approve and enact Laws by Band Council Resolution, except where a meeting of Members or ratification vote is required.

### Lands Committee (LMAC)

- Recommend to Council Laws, policies, and procedures related to LNIB Lands.
- Review draft Laws and provide comments to the Lands Department during the early drafting stage.
- Collaborate and engage with Members on Laws relating to LNIB Lands during the Community Collaboration stage.
- Attend and participate in Land Code related meetings.

### LNIB Members

- Attend Community Collaboration meetings to provide input.
- Participate in meetings of Members or ratification votes where required.

### Lands Department

- Make recommendations to the LMAC and Council on the development of Laws, policies, and procedures regarding LNIB Lands.
- Oversee and provide directions to Legal Counsel on the drafting of Laws on behalf of Council.
- Facilitate the sharing of information between Members and Council regarding Law development.
- Ensure compliance with LNIB Laws.

### LNIB Legal Counsel

Where instructed by the Lands Department:

- Draft clear and comprehensive Laws;
- Identify and resolve issues related to:
  - Jurisdiction and authority;
  - Administrative law;
  - Canadian charters, acts, and laws;
  - Other LNIB Laws; and
- Address financial, procedural, and other practical implications of a proposed Law.
